## Result of the Helice Referees Course 24<sup>th</sup> Nov 2018

### Held at Rugby and District Trap Club

The first FITASC theoretical and practical Helice Referees course to be held in the UK under the new FITASC protocol can be seen as a great leap forward in the UK for the organising of Helice competitions.

The success of the course was largely down to the active participation of the instructor for the course Brian Metson, (Brian is one of two Helice International referees in the UK), and the experiences he drew down on over his past involvement in the discipline.

Not forgetting the support offered by John Nightingale who hosted the event, without a host the course would not have taken place

Feedback on the course has been very positive backed up with the results as follows:

There were 11 participants, there were eight 100% results one 98.75%, one 96.25% and one 93.75%.

The acceptable pass is 90% and the **2019** examination procedure was utilised.
